An Evening with Maggie Anton, author of *Rashi's Daughters*

Maggie Anton was raised in a secular, socialist household; she reached adulthood with little knowledge of her Jewish religion. Upon meeting her future husband, they both began a lifetime of Jewish education, synagogue involvement, and ritual observance. After studying in a woman's Talmud class, Maggie Anton became intrigued with the idea that Rashi, one of the greatest Jewish scholars ever, had no sons, only three daughters. Slowly but surely, she began to research the family and the time in which they lived. Much was written about Rashi, but almost nothing of the daughters, except their names and the names of their husbands. Legend has it that Rashi's daughters were learned in a time when women were traditionally forbidden to study the sacred texts. These forgotten women seemed ripe for rediscovery, and the idea of a book about them was born.

An enthralling and well-researched novel of women's lives in the Jewish world of eleventh century France. Blending authentic passages of Talmudic argument with the imagined human dramas of the household of the medieval scholar Salomon ben Isaac, Rashi's Daughters entertains and educates."
