Class starts week of October 24, 2011

Whether you think that God did it or that modern life is full of distressing surprises, we are repeatedly given challenging circumstances to master. Our tradition tells us that working on these challenges is our central task, our purpose on earth. Mussar, a centuries old practice of spiritual examination, provides guidance in uncovering our assignments and working on them in a constructive and increasingly joyous way. Using *Everyday Holiness*, written by Alan Morinis of The Mussar Institute, we'll learn the basic theory of Mussar, and explore practices for gaining clarity and improvement in the soul traits (middot) of Humility, Gratitude, Silence, Enthusiasm, and Trust.
