Robert Hovden's Honey Cake (parve)

2 cups white all purpose flour	lined pans (2 x 9" round cake pans or 1 sheet pan half size (approx 12" x 18")). Bake at 350 degrees for 25 - 35 minutes until done (toothpick comes out clean). Remove from oven and immediately brush on honey topping onto hot cake (1/4 cup honey + 2 Tbl hot water, mixed thoroughly). <i>Removing the cake from the pans can be tricky - this is why I usually have the parchment paper sticking up and out of the cake pan; I use that to slide the cake out or you end up taking off pieces of the top.</i>
1 cup dark brown sugar	
1 cup plain applesauce	
½ cup honey (you will need another ¼ cup later for a total of ¾ cup)	
1/6 cup molasses	
½ cup vegetable oil	
2 eggs	
2 tsp baking powder	
1 ½ tsp salt	
3 Tbl cinnamon	
1 Tbl nutmeg	
½ tsp ginger	
1/6 tsp cloves	
¼ tsp cardamom	
Mix all ingredients together until well blended. Pour into
