Pirkei Avot - שיעור פרקי אבות and the commentary of Me'am Lo'ez with Yischah Smith

Avoth (Pirkei Avot – The Ethics of the Fathers) is the one Talmudic tract that explores the very roots of Judaism. It has long been regarded as a rare treasure of our Torah tradition. Pirkei Avot, as contrasted with the Talmud's discussions around Jewish law, centers our attention directly on the Jew's efforts to improve one's relationship with G-d and fellow human being. Of all the many commentaries written on Avoth, perhaps the clearest is that published in 1747 by Rabbi Yitzchak Margiso of Constantinople, as part of the famed Me'am Lo'ez series.
